Cedar Pointe Drive Access Closure Notice at Dunlop Street Dunlop St. Interchange Trunk Sanitary Relocation

Start Date: July 10, 2023
End Date: September 15, 2023
Timeline is subject to change.

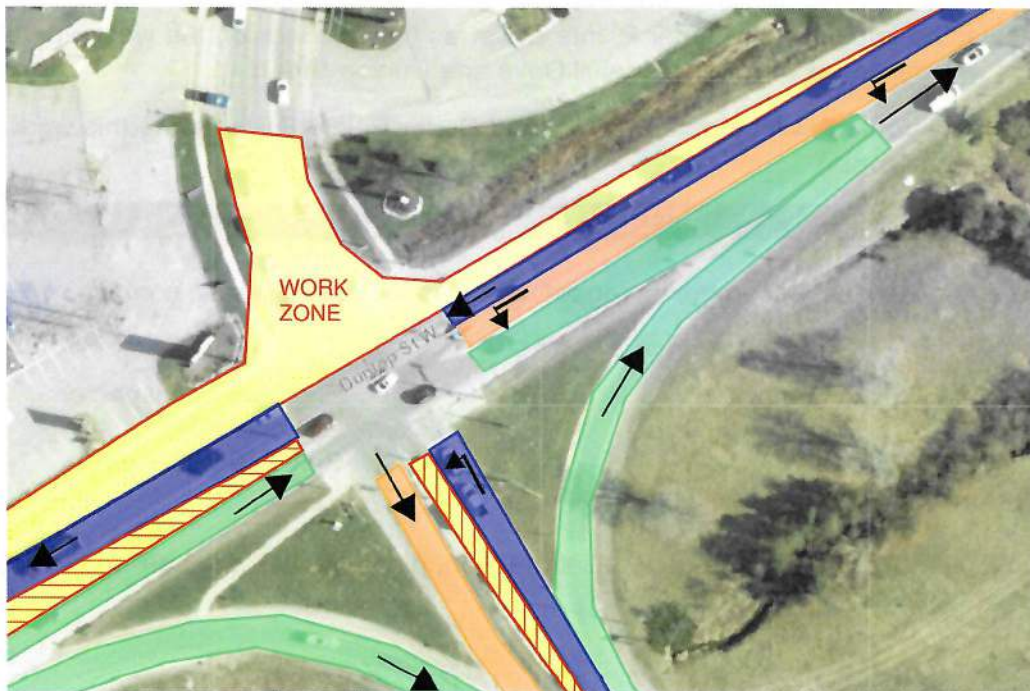
This information bulletin is to provide ten days written notice to all businesses on Cedar Pointe Drive, to help plan for alternate route access for services such as, deliveries and notifying customers. The City has obtained Clearway Construction Incorporated (Clearway) to complete the work with the planned start date of July 10, 2023. The intended duration of work in the identified construction zone (map below) is approximately two months.

WORK DETAILS

Clearway will be doing the following work:

- Installing temporary traffic signals;
- Watermain removal and replacement within the intersection of Dunlop Street West and Cedar Pointe Drive;
- Microtunneling works to install the trunk sanitary sewer from Hart Drive to Dunlop Street.
- Connecting to the existing sanitary sewer along Dunlop Street.

IMPACTS

Pedestrian access will be impacted near and in the construction zone. Sidewalks along the north side of Dunlop Street East will be closed from Sarjeant Drive to Cedar Point Drive. Pedestrian access will also be impacted on Cedar Point Drive, as the sidewalk on the west side of Cedar Point Drive will be closed between Edgehill Drive and Dunlop Street.

Barrie Transit bus route 6 will be detoured to avoid Cedar Point Drive during this work (similar to the above detour route).
